## GAME PREVIEW By Norm Weber

### St. Edward vs. Glenville: Ohio Football Showdown

#### Upcoming Matchup

St. Edward advances its series against Ohio teams with a highly anticipated game against Glenville at First Federal Lakewood Stadium. Glenville (2-1) will be the Eagles' (3-0) third Ohio opponent this season, with kick-off scheduled for 7 p.m. Friday.

#### Glenville's Key Players

A standout for Glenville is All-Ohio linebacker Cincere Johnson, whose defensive presence has consistently disrupted rival offenses. "They are a talented team," remarked St. Edward head coach Tom Lombardo. Johnson, standing at 6-foot-3 and weighing 225 pounds, has committed to Ohio State and remains focused on the current season.

Glenville also boasts a quarterback with versatile passing and running abilities, complemented by two running backs each offering distinctive styles. Their offensive line provides solid protection for these skilled athletes. "They're big up front, so they have the necessary components to be competitive," Lombardo noted.

#### Competitive Schedules

St. Edward regularly chooses strong opponents, including schools from outside Ohio, to strengthen its football program. Glenville opened its season facing a Division I state champion and two Division II state champions, securing a 2-1 record with victories over teams such as Massillon and Liberty. Their lone loss was to Avon.

Coach Lombardo noted that Olentangy Liberty lost nearly 30 seniors last year, a factor that shaped their recent contest. Previously, Liberty's roster included several

athletes who competed in state championship teams across multiple sports.

Both St. Edward and Glenville maintain rigorous schedules and will face Hoban later in Akron. Glenville, a member of the Senate Athletic Conference, has five league games and a non-league slate filled with competitive rivals. The team ends its season against Rhodes, a Senate opponent currently undefeated at 3-0.

#### Recent Performances

In St. Edward's 63-27 victory over Wayne at Euclid Community Stadium, Ryan Mikovsky led with six catches for 89 yards, while six receivers contributed overall. Special teams excelled, with Will Lavelle converting all seven extra-point attempts and Luke Andrachick adding another.

Senior wideout Zach Hacklemen continues to rewrite the record books with his most recent performance (4 catches and 2 TD's). He is now tied for most career pass catches and touchdown receptions with former Eagle Alex Stump (2012-2014).

#### Team Strengths and Outlook

Glenville is not a team to underestimate. "Gosh, no," Lombardo affirmed. "They are going to make a deep playoff run in Division IV. They are certainly the most talented team in Division IV, no question about that."

Offensively, St. Edward has amassed 135 points over three games, averaging 45 points per game. Glenville has totaled 62 points this season, averaging 21 points per game, yet numbers alone don't tell the whole story. Glenville is an explosive team with lots of playmakers that can change the complexion of the game on either side of the ball.

## **JP FARLEY PLAYER OF THE GAME:**

Johnny Evanchick had 281 total yards vs. Wayne. He was 12 of 13 passing for 214 yards and three touchdowns.

Evanchick also ran for 67 yards which included a 45 yard touchdown run. This was all done in the first half.

## **RECORD TYING GAME AGAIN:**

Zack Hackleman had another record tying day. The Eagle wideout caught four passes, which tied him for most career receptions (92) with Alex Stump. (2012-2014)

His second touchdown of the game also tied him with Stump for career touchdowns (18)

## **POINTS GALORE:**

The 63 points versus Wayne was the second highest since 2019. That year the Eagles put up 73 points in a playoff game against Medina. The record for points in a game was 84 against Ashtabula St. John in 1961.

Tom Lombardo picked up his 80 regular season win as coach of the Eagles. His overall record with St. Ed's is 118-22

## **NOTABLE DEFENSE:**

The defense has held opponents to under 100 yards rushing two out of three games. Wayne was held to 25 yards on the ground.

Last week, five players had double digit tackles led by Adrian Peterson (19T, 2 TFL, 1 sack, Fumble Recovery for TD) Landon Lehmer had 17 Tackles.
