GAME PREVIEW By Norm Weber

The Battle of the Saints

Throw out the record books—this game will be charged with emotion and spirit as St. Edward faces Saint Ignatius in the annual Battle of the Saints.

Historic Rivalry Returns

St. Edward and Saint Ignatius will meet on the gridiron for the 59th time in the modern era, a tradition renewed in 1971. The highly anticipated matchup will take place at 7 p.m. Friday inside First Federal Lakewood Stadium.

Roots of the Rivalry

This storied rivalry began when players were mainly drawn from the West Side and the Westshore suburbs. In earlier years, grade schools in the area would send their athletes to one of the two schools, fostering competitive spirit. Today, both high schools draw from nearly 50 grade schools, continuing the tradition and respect for history that has defined this rivalry since its seeds came to fruition in the 1980s.

Coach's Perspective

St. Edward head coach Tom Lombardo acknowledges the intensity of the rivalry. "Of course, the players and coaches know that it is a rivalry," Lombardo said. "Our records are a little different this year, but we have to take this naturally. They have scholarship players on the team."

Heading into the game, the Eagles hold a 5-1 record, while the Wildcats are at 1-5. Despite the difference in records, Lombardo recognizes Saint Ignatius's strengths: "Their offense is solid in the running game, which has been proven early on. They've made some mistakes that have led to letting the game get away from them. They are very capable. They have a good corps of running backs and two big receivers. They have good players."

If Saint Ignatius can put everything together, they could climb in the computer rankings to become the 12th-best team in the region. Lombardo commented, "They are playing for the playoffs. If they can win, that puts them in the playoff picture in Region I, which is all teams' goal including teams in front of

them."

Recent Performances

Following a loss to Massillon, the Eagles rebounded last week by defeating Bishop McNamara. Coach Lombardo emphasized the energetic atmosphere: "You get out there and there's the student body and the packed crowd. We're working to learn how to play well, too."

He also praised Saint Ignatius's receiving and running game: "They have two really good receivers. They have a corps of running backs that are good. They have had difficulty in the quarterback division."

Defensive Strengths and Challenges

On defense, Lombardo highlighted the Wildcats' linebacking corps as an outstanding strength: "This is the strength of the team."

However, mistakes have been a challenge for Saint Ignatius. "They shot themselves in the foot a little bit," Lombardo noted. "They've been taking some big hits. It is a good opportunity for them. They have drawn a lot of penalties. If they eliminate the penalties and put it all together it could be a heck of a game."

JP FARLEY PLAYER OF THE GAME:

Zack Hackleman's three touchdown reception day garnered him player of the game award.

He tied his record for most touchdowns in a game with three. He has now done it three times in two seasons.

TD STREAK:

The Eagles touchdown streak is at 43 games. It's the longest streak since a 31 game streak was snapped in 2022 with a 6-0 win at Cincinnati Moeller.

STREAK ON THE LINE:

The Eagles streak of holding opponents under 40 points a game is now at 100 games.

RULE OF 15:

If the Eagles hold St. Ignatius to less than 13 points they are 28-0.

If the Wildcats score 14 points, St. Edward is 1-3-1.

If the Eagles allow more than 15 points in a game they are 3-30

TOUGH POINTS:

St. Ignatius has been held to single digits in six of the last seven games.

The most points given up by the Eagles in that span was 14 in 2021

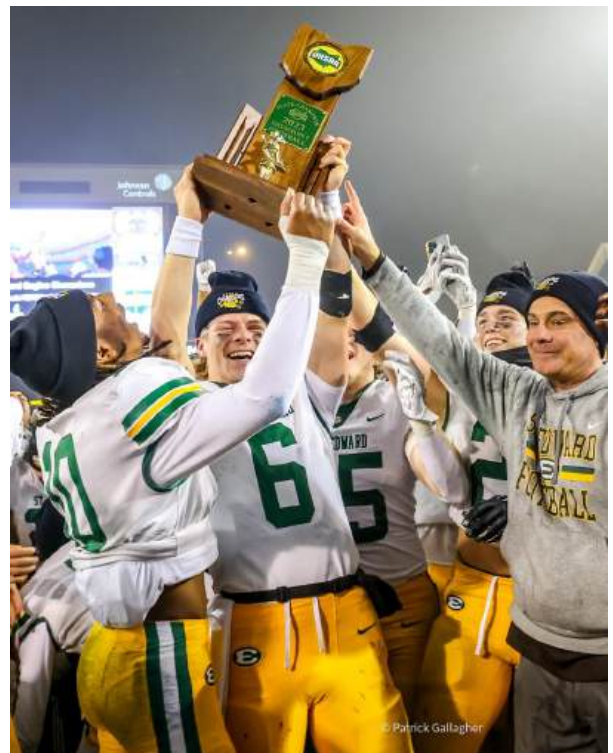
