## GAME PREVIEW By Norm Weber

### Football North vs. St. Edward Eagles Overview

Football North, a rapidly improving high school football program from Canada, will travel to Lakewood to take on the St. Edward varsity football Eagles. This matchup marks a return for Football North, whose team has shown significant growth and maturity since their first meeting with St. Edward seven years ago.

### Football North: A Program on the Rise

The Chargers, currently holding a 3-3 record, have established themselves as an up-and-coming team with a roster filled with talent and recent successes. According to St. Edward head coach Tom Lombardo, "They are a quality football team. They have size on the lines, really good skill, and an experienced quarterback who has been playing for them for a while. They have a tall, strong, rangy guy playing at wide receiver."

Football North also faces a challenging schedule, competing against teams such as Walsh Jesuit (6-1), Detroit Catholic Central (6-1), The St. James Academy (4-0), Massillon (4-3), and St. Edward (6-1). Their offense is notably strong, although they have conceded a considerable number of points in some games. Despite this, their offensive unit remains solid and capable of explosive plays.

The Chargers have faced tough opponents, with half of their games being against teams with just one or no losses. Their results include high-scoring affairs such as 30-6, 41-28, and 76-42, confirming their ability to pursue deep and dynamic offensive plays. Coach Lombardo noted, "They have some schemes. They have good guys up front. They have a tackle who is going to the University of Maine, who is a really good player."

Their quarterback has been a consistent starter since their previous quarterback moved on to Ohio University after playing St. Edward three years ago in Bay Village.

### St. Edward Eagles: Building on Momentum

Following a decisive victory over Saint Ignatius last week, the Eagles are now focused on their final three games of the season, approaching them one at a time. Coach Lombardo expressed confidence in his team's progress: "We're finding our groove, if you will. We're efficient. We are playing ahead of the chains. We're averaging a lot of yards on first down. We're scoring in the red zone. We're able to get some explosive plays."

Currently, the Eagles are scoring on about 90 percent of their possessions. "When we put that altogether that's what happens – we score a lot of points," Coach Lombardo added.

Though the win over Ignatius gave the Eagles an edge in the all-time series, the team recognizes there are still areas for improvement. "They had a good plan against us and it took a while for our defense to settle in," Coach Lombardo reflected. "We had a good beginning of the fourth quarter. We're going down the field to settle in on a running clock. Then we gave up the ball and they go down and score."

The goal for the Eagles is to build on their strengths and perform even better in future games. "We learn from it," Coach Lombardo said. He acknowledged the quality of the Ignatius team, praising their line, backs, receivers, and linebackers. Last week's game was described as a classic, intense, and fast-paced "Battle of the Saints" played at First Federal Lakewood Stadium. "It was a good game all around. You throw out the record books, and the kids are trying harder because of the rivalry. It's tough to win either way, but I'm glad we won."

### Recent Results and Looking Ahead

In a notable result two weeks ago, Massillon committed seven turnovers against the Chargers, leading to a 34-2 victory for Football North. The Chargers held a 13-2 lead at halftime, and Massillon's turnovers in the second half proved decisive.

Coach Lombardo concluded, "Let's keep doing the things we do well and improve on the other things."

## JP FARLEY PLAYER OF THE GAME:

Zack Hackleman's three touchdown reception day garnered him player of the game award.

He tied his record for most touchdowns in a game with three. He has now done it three times in two seasons.

## TD STREAK:

The Eagles touchdown streak is at 44 games. It's the longest streak since a 31 game streak was snapped in 2022 with a 6-0 win at Cincinnati Moeller.

## STREAK ON THE LINE:

The Eagles streak of holding opponents under 40 points a game is now at 101 games.

## ANOTHER GAME ANOTHER RECORD:

Zack Hackleman's three touchdowns against St. Ignatius gives him 12 on the season. That broke a record he set last year with 10 touchdown catches in a 10 game season.

The three touchdown receptions also tied a record for most in game he set now for the fourth time, three times this season.

Hackleman is now the all time leader for touchdown receptions and pass catches. He has 113 catches which broke Alex Stump's record of 92. He also has 25 career receiving touchdowns.

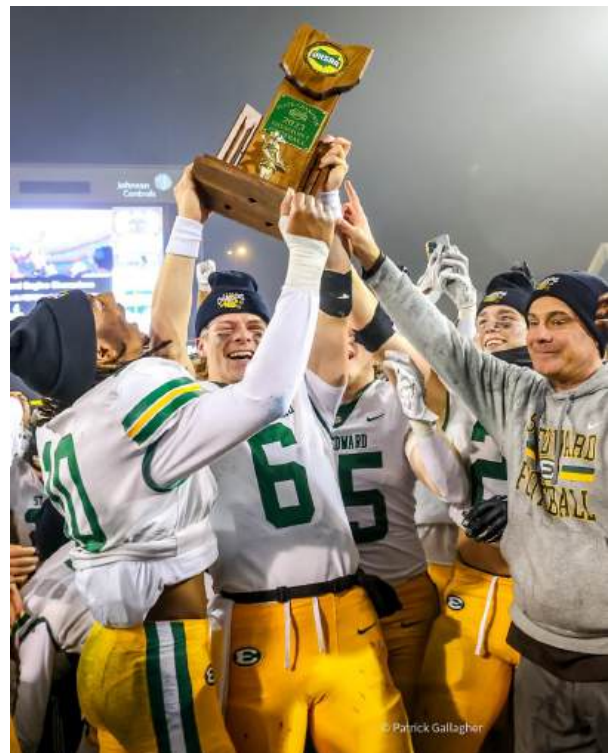
