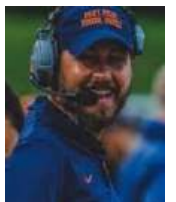

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GAME PREVIEW By Norm Weber Eagles Prepare for Playoff Challenge Against Berea-Midpark

Introduction

In the second round of the playoffs, all eyes are on the Eagles as they prepare to see whether their status as the No. 1 seed and the accompanying bye week will give them an advantage or potentially disrupt their momentum. Their opponent, the No. 8 seed Berea-Midpark Titans, secured their place in this matchup by defeating Cleveland Heights in the first round. The Titans are known for their high-powered offense, making for an intriguing contest.

Matchup Background

The upcoming regional quarterfinal game is set for 7 p.m. Friday at First Federal Lakewood Stadium. This marks only the second time the Eagles and Titans have faced off in the playoffs, and notably, just the second instance since 1974 that a Southwestern Conference team has matched up with the Eagles. The last time this occurred was when former coach Mike Currence brought his previous school, Westlake, to play against the Eagles. Before merging their schools, the Eagles faced Berea and Midpark consecutively in the 1986 playoffs and emerged victorious in both matchups.

Coaches' Perspectives

Eagles head coach Tom Lombardo recognizes the challenge ahead, describing Berea-Midpark's offense as "high-octane" and capable of executing plays at a rapid pace. He notes their ability to score prolifically, especially in recent games. The Titans demonstrated this offensive firepower in their 48-24 victory over Cleveland Heights. Quarterback Dylan Papushak completed 27 of 36 passes for 437 yards and seven touchdowns. The Titans have four receivers this year with over 500 receiving yards: Dylan Maddox (68 catches, 1,248 yards, 15 TDs), Dylan Maddox (43 catches, 906 yards, 2 TDs), Tyson Clay (47 catches, 753 yards, 10 TDs), and Andre Alexander (32 catches, 501 yards, 10 TDs).

Coach Lombardo acknowledges that his defense will be thoroughly tested. He points out that Berea-Midpark has a strong group of receivers and a talented quarterback, with both their inside and outside wide receivers posing threats on the field. Many of these Titans players have participated in St. Ed's quarterback, big-man, and general football camps over the years, providing Coach Lombardo with some familiarity with their abilities and character.

Bye Week Considerations

Although Coach Lombardo admits he is not typically a proponent of bye weeks, he concedes that this one may offer the Eagles an advantage given the playoff context. He remains cautious, however, noting that the true impact of the bye week and the expanded 12-team playoff structure will only become clear as games are played and more experience is gained over the coming years. He points out that while some teams may benefit and advance, others risk losing their rhythm.

For now, the additional preparation time has proven beneficial for the Eagles. Coaches and players attended the Berea-Midpark versus Cleveland Heights game in person, relying on traditional scouting methods instead of modern digital tools. Coach Lombardo emphasizes that while the risk of falling out of rhythm exists, the team used the week off to focus on internal improvement, holding a high-quality practice and dedicating time to areas they aimed to strengthen.

Looking Ahead

The Eagles are eager to return to the field and put their preparation to the test. Coach Lombardo is confident in the scouting report his staff assembled, highlighting that their "get-better" week emphasized competition within the team, fostering growth and readiness. With both the Titans and the Eagles having scored 40 or more points multiple times this season—Berea-Midpark four times, and St. Edward five times—fans can expect an exciting, high-scoring battle as the teams vie for a spot in the next round.

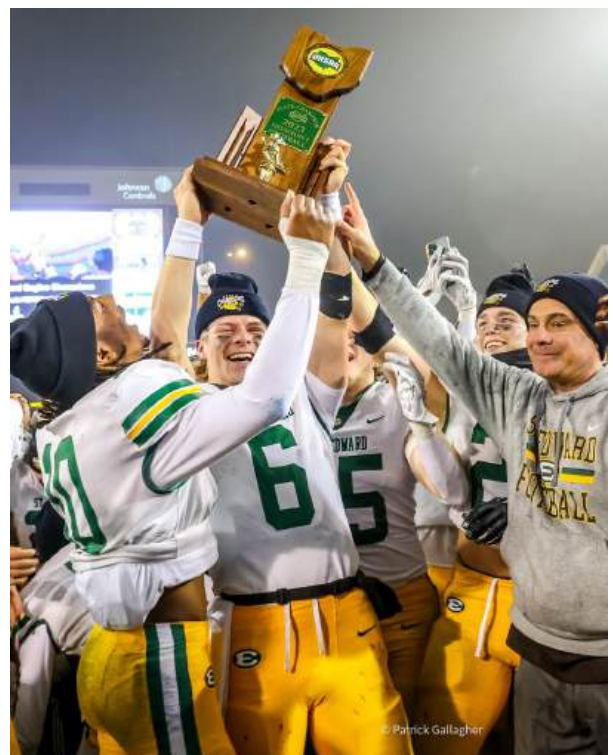
